"We need to find her mom and fast. I need to tell her that I am so sorry from the bottom of my heart I swear" I say and tears stream down my face.

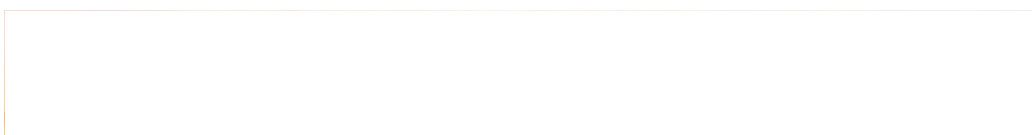
"It's going to be okay Mpilo"
