We have to give them a gifts, and they give us as well

Uncle: and we don't take short cuts, when it comes to tradition

Me: just like how we don't with ours, so please lets give the Dube's a chance to do theirs

Dad: well at least they can keep it down, and send a text that they've arrived

Me: they're supposed to shout so you can hear them from the gate

He shakes his head

Dad: I don't think that's normal

Wow!

Me: please don't even ask them that tomorrow, better yet don't even mention it. Lets them do things their way

Dad: for your sake

Me: well thank you

This is something new

We're Africans yes, but then our tradition isn't like that of theirs

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Luzuko

I can't wait for the day to pass

I had our packed boxes moved from the apartment to the house yesterday
While everyone kept running around, with these things of theirs for the negotiations

And I seriously don't get what's the big deal

Zuri: you woke me up

She's grumpy, but I wanted to talk to her

I thought I won't be allowed in these negotiations, but apparently I am

So I'll be inside with them, and that means not being able to talk to my wife

I'm just assuming that's what he said, in his own words

That man feels himself way too much okay, and not in a bad way

He can fucking throw shade at you, while he's still smiling at you

We've been standing here for 20 minutes now, that's long

Njabulo: I hope this is the first and the last time we do such things

He's the type that married a wife through home affairs and that was it

Me: oh well, at least I suggested something. And that woman is already my wife, can't I just pay? I mean like is there a need for all this?

Njabulo: at this present moment, I have a feeling you still need to be taught your culture

He says as some guy opens the gate, he looks so bored

These people are crazy, they'll make you pay to even sit down

Zuri: baba (dad)

Nyiko: do you know these people?

She wants to give me a heart attack, as she goes quite

Nyiko: you can lift your head, and look at them

She slowly lifts her head, but her eyes are just stuck on my

Nyiko: so?

This man knows how to ruin a moment

Zuri: yes, I know them

Nyiko: alright, you can excuse us

She gets up slowly, and walks away

Nyiko: your son was ought to know his own wife
